1. Welcome and Minutes of last Meeting

Derek welcomed everyone and each person gave the usual introductions. The report of the January & March 2009 meetings will be sent out later.

2. Chairman's Reports

Nice to see so many people here especially those who have come a long way (eg John Reid from Hawick & John Hunter from Selkirk)

Derek is going again to the Royal College of Surgeons as a guinea pig. He says it's quite nice to go & speak to medical students, if you get asked to do it, he recommends you say yes. Liz has been too. One of our members Prof Will got people involved with this and at Scottish conference last year Derek mentioned it to the Head Office Chairperson who was interested to know about it.

Derek then summarised the meetings of the past year:

At our last AGM in May 2008 Peter Smeaton spoke on the importance of getting plenty of rest.

On 10 August we had a nice trip to Falkirk Wheel, which was organised by young Frances and well attended. It was really good.

At our September meeting there was an interesting demonstration of aromatherapy by Susan McVicker.

At the November meeting we had a talk by Dr Jon Stone from the Western General on the different types of Ataxia, and enjoyed a nice meal afterwards at the Laird & Dog in Lasswade. This was the second year running for our early Christmas meal.

In January we had a Burns supper meeting with a good turnout including Ronnie Browne doing a reading.

The March speaker was from VOCAL - very interesting and informative.

On 4 April five of us had a trip to the Alona Hotel in Strathclyde Park, where we had a very enjoyable meeting with the West of Scotland Branch with a lot of their members, including Harriet Bonney, their new Chairperson.

3. Election of Branch Officers

The Chairman Derek Main, Secretary Penny Gardner and Treasurer Frances Wright were re-elected, unopposed.

4. Treasurer's Report

Doreen Vandeppear presented a cheque for £120 from the Edinburgh Women's Townswomen's guild. Also another one from her neighbour of £35 for Jim's sponsored cycle ride (Frances has some money for Jim too).

The annual accounts for the year ended 31 March 2009 were approved and are appended to this report. Total income was £1,259.83 and expenditure £520.46 therefore there was a surplus for the year of £739.37. The bank balance at the beginning was £2582.91, plus surplus £739.37 less donation to HO £2,500 means £822.28 carried forward.

Frances reported that, since March, the income has been from Anne Marie's knitting, two standing orders of £10 each, collecting cans and donations. Yesterday's cheque for £112 from Mrs Thomson & Doreen's cheque today are yet to be paid in plus there are 2 full collection cans from Lasswade (none of these paid in yet). An increase in members' voluntary subs would be good.

The bank balance was £1,122.08 at the end of April 2009.

5. Social Events and Fundraising

Frances suggested we think about social events over the summer - does anyone have any ideas? Suggestions included the Bo'ness & Kinneil Railway, Blair Drummond safari park (we could hire a bus – maybe get a discount?). BBQ? But finding someone to do the cooking may be a problem.
